We are thrilled to announce that Creative Community Services has been awarded a \$50,000 grant by CareSource, a nationally recognized non-profit dedicated to transforming health care.

The grant is for preparing youth to transition out of foster care with the skills needed to successfully become as independent as possible. This includes job coaching, support groups, skill-based workshops, and cultural and recreational opportunities for our youth.

That's how many kids are in Georgia's foster care system. **CCS averages** around 40 therapeutic foster homes a year. We need your help in providing more safe homes to children in need.

She connected with local leaders about the importance of therapeutic foster care and ongoing therapeutic care throughout an individual's lifetime. You can **learn more about the summit here.**


